Welcome & Check In

Before you arrive, please check out our What to Bring webpage:

For example, we do not provide linen, blankets, or pillows. Please also bring your own towels, soap and shampoo.

Your presentations will be collected at the time of registration/check in. Please bring your talk either on a flash drive or on your computer. The main projector is a native 16:10 ratio, so an HD widescreen format presentation will look best, although the older 4:3 ratio is also supported.

Sunday, September 16 Arrival

For those arriving on Sunday, September 16, please check in at the board room of the Billy Barr Community Center between 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm. Dinner is at 6:00 pm at the Billy Barr Community Center on September 16 for those residing in Gothic. We do not recommend that people unfamiliar with the site arrive after dark.

Monday, September 17 Field Trip

For anybody who has signed up for the Monday, September 17 field trip, please meet at 9:00 am outside the Visitor Center in Gothic. Bring your hiking gear, such as backpack, non-cotton warm layer and hat, rain jacket, 1-2 liters of water, sturdy shoes, sun hat/sunscreen, and sack lunch. Optional: binoculars, camera, field notebook. For those registered to prepare a sack lunch at the community center, please prepare your sandwich and condiments between 7:30 am - 8:30 am on September 17 in the Billy Barr Community Center.

Monday, September 17 Arrival

If you are arriving on Monday, September 17, please check in at the board room of the Billy Barr Community Center between 3:00 pm and 6:00 pm. There is no lunch served in the dining hall on September 17. Dinner is at 6:00 pm at the Billy Barr Community Center. We do not recommend that people unfamiliar with the site arrive after dark. The first lecture will begin at 7:30 pm in the Billy Barr Community Center.

Travel within Gothic

Long-term research is spread throughout the town site, often next to cabins, driveways, and parking areas. Please honor the 10 mph speed limit while driving within the Gothic townsite. Because of the number of research sites please only walk on established pathways.

- Dinner 6 pm - 6:30 pm

Food will be served during the first 30 minutes of a meal. Participants are welcome to stay longer after the food is served.

Internet & Phones & Computer Lab

Please connect any devices to the RMBL-Net wireless network (password: rmbllscience). For help email helpdesk@rmbl.org. Unless you have wi-fi calling or the ability to skype, there is no cell phone reception in Gothic; there is cell service in the nearby towns of Mt. Crested Butte and Crested Butte. The Barclay Building has a computer lab with 12 computers, where you can work on computers, print & scan.

Shower House & Water

Unless you are booked in to a Premium cabin your cabin will likely not have water when you arrive. Water jugs are available in cabins for your needs. All water is potable in Gothic. If your cabin does not have water, you can fill jugs provided in the cabins at the following locations: Gothic Research Center, Gates (outdoor spigot) or Maroon (outdoor spigot).

People without working showers in their cabins can shower in the Shower House. You will then need to bring your own toiletries and towels.

Cleaning Shed & Outhouses

Participants are responsible for cleaning their own cabin during their stay (no maid service). Cleaning supplies, such as multi-purpose cleaner, paper towels, and a mop are available in the cleaning shed just outside of the Johnson Lab across from the Administrative Building. The cleaning shed also has supplies, such as batteries, snap traps to catch mice, and lightbulbs.

You can find toilet paper in the laundry room inside the Shower House. Please remember to close the lid and shut the door when exiting the outhouse. Also, do not throw any foreign objects (feminine products, condoms, etc.) into the outhouse.

Recycling Shed & Dumpsters

- Trash dumpsters are near the Maintenance Shop (west of town) and the Johnson Lab (east of town). Be sure to close the lid and secure the bar;
- The recycling shed is located on the main road to the right between the Visitor Center and the Community Center. Recycling instructions are posted in the recycling shed. In one set of bins we recycle broken down cardboard & paper; in the other bin we recycle clean plastics, cans, tins, & glass. No trash please.

Be Bear Aware

Use proper bear etiquette. Please properly dispose of food and trash in the bear-proof dumpsters. Please do not dispose of food in cans without bear-proof lids, or in the recycling shed. Refrain from leaving food or trash in your vehicle or outside. If you see a bear, please leave it alone. Do not leave food in your cabin when you check out. They will break into empty cabins.

Check-Out and Cleaning Cabins

Please check out of your cabin on the day of your departure by 11 am. You are responsible for cleaning your cabin before departure. A cleaning charge of \$45/hour will be billed to you, if cabins are not properly cleaned. RMBL reserves the right to recover damages to cabins.

To clean your cabin, please do the following: Trash goes in the dumpsters; Recycling goes in recycling shed; Fires must be put completely out, or electric space heaters must be turned off; Floors must be swept and mopped; Surfaces must be wiped; Leftover food should be thrown away and refrigerator should be cleaned.

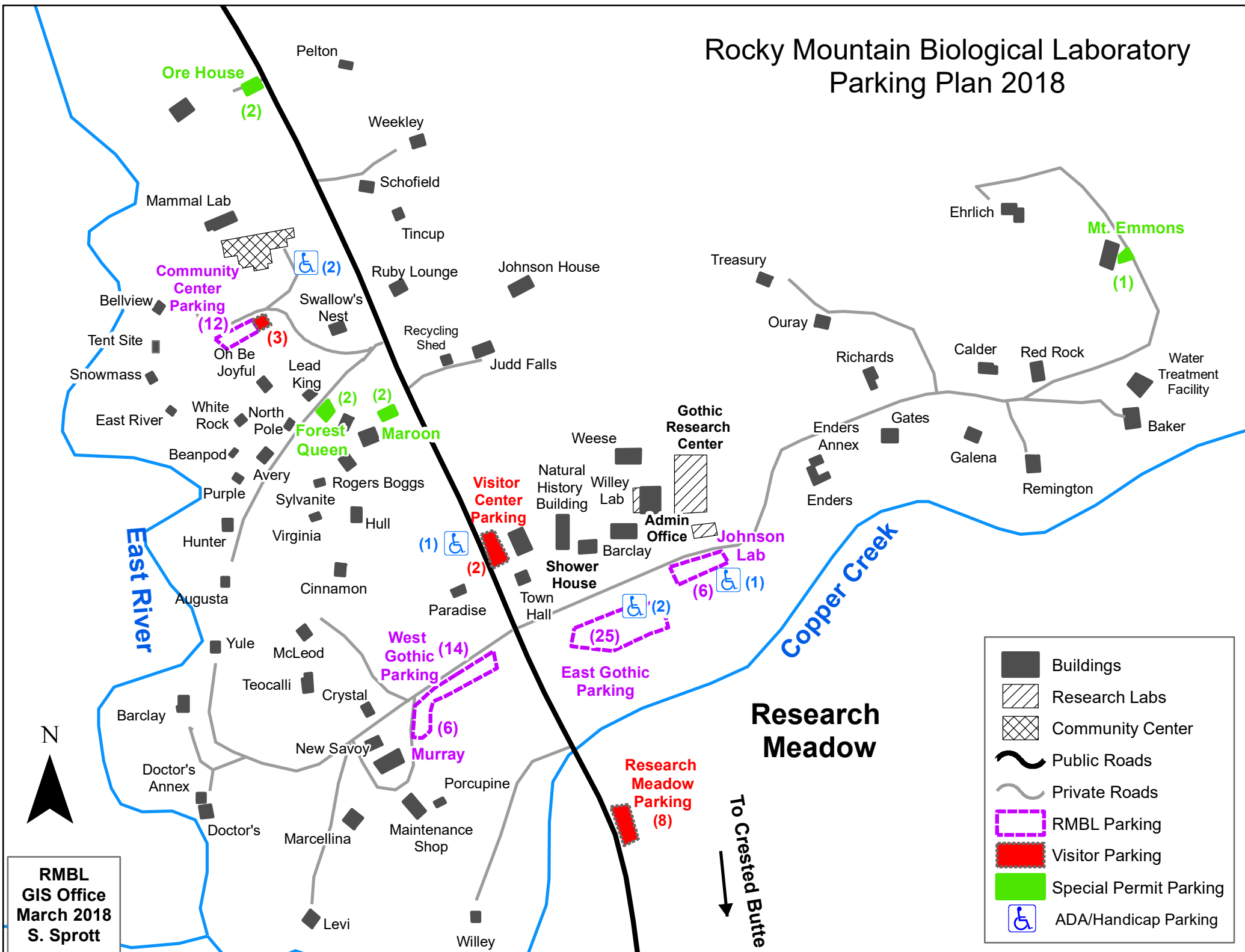
Emergencies
